PLANTING NOTES

PLANTING HOLES SHOULD BE TWICE THE DIAMETER OF THE ROOTBALL WITH THE SIDES AND BOTTOM OF THE HOLES BROKEN UP. PLANT ROOT BALL SHOULD BE SLIT ON SIDES WITH A KNIFE TO BREAK OUT ROOTS. LIGHTLY TAMP AND WATER IN WELL.

AFTER PLANT INSTALLATION, COVER PLANTING AREAS WITH DECOMPOSED, SLIVERLESS BARK MULCH (SUCH AS DARK HEMLOCK) TO A DEPTH OF 3", AVOIDING ALL PLANT BASES AND TRUNKS.

ALL PLANTS SHOULD BE WATERED REGULARLY DURING FIRST TWO YEARS.
