Greetings! There are several new faces in the neighborhood. We welcome you all and urge you to come to board meetings and meet some of the other residents. The judgment of those present was that "stored" cars or trucks detract from Wheatherstone's attractiveness and take up our limited parking space. Since the annual meeting was lightly attended (more proxies than people), and since parking questions seem to generate emotional sparks, we think everyone ought to be heard on this issue. Accordingly, please let us have your opinions by completing the attached survey and returning it in the enclosed envelope. We need your input to help us make good decisions.

NOW THAT SUMMER IS HERE, PLEASE REMEMBER TO WATER YOUR FRONT AREAS. Shrubs and trees have been sprayed recently for bug infestation. You can do your part to keep this problem at a minimum if you will hose off your shrubs, particularly the under side of the leaves, when you water. This will help to keep our spraying costs down.

We are proud of the way Wheatherstone looks but much needs to be done. The Board is investigating ways to upgrade the entrance; the holes in the roads will be repaired this month; and discussions are being held to determine what should be done to improve the appearance of the easement in back of Wheatherstone Street. PLEASE don't dump trash in that area - call Mt. Park for a curbside pickup on the 1st and 3rd Mondays of each month.
